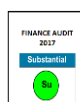
Dear Parents/Carers,

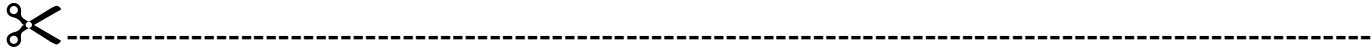
Our theme this week: Parables
