## Parents Evening

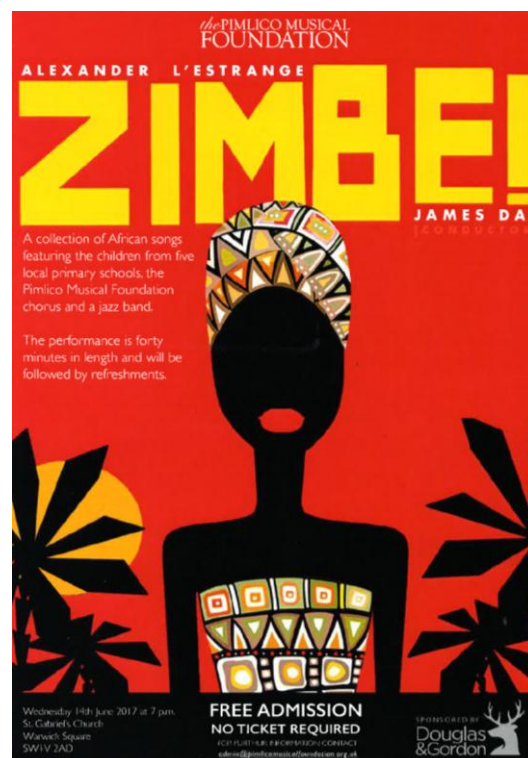
