Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back to the new school year. I hope you all had a lovely Summer Holiday! It is fantastic to see all of our children back in school and looking refreshed after the summer break.

I would like to take this opportunity to say a very warm welcome to all of the new members of our school community, to new children and parents throughout the school and to our Class 1 Teacher Laura Rollo, our Class 3 Teacher Elise Page and to our Class 5 Teacher Isaac Azah.

School has been open over the holidays and we have had a very busy summer with various work carried out across the school building. We have had new heating pipes fitted in the kitchen, old boilers removed in the basement and we have had the kitchen painted! We are also in the middle of the completion of a new fire alarm system being installed. Our technicians didn't quite manage to finish by the time the children returned and so you may notice a few unfinished sections of wiring around the building. This is perfectly safe as it is not connected yet. Until the new fire alarm system is up and running and has been tested, our existing fire alarm system will continue to run in its place.

On Monday and Tuesday the staff had training days. We looked at our new Religious Education Scheme of Work, discussed our Teaching and Learning Policy and looked at marking. We also discussed our Lockdown Procedures, School Behaviour Policy, Collective Worship and our School Improvement Priorities for the coming year.

During INSET days we have Pupil Progress Meetings. These are opportunities for the class teachers and the Senior Leadership Team to discuss each class, how individual children are progressing and to determine any concerns or extra need within a class.

### Meet the Teacher

In the coming week all parents will have an opportunity to visit their child's classroom, meet their child's class teacher and find out about what your child will be learning in the coming term. Dates and times are as follows:

If you find that you are unable to make the meeting, your child's teacher is always in the playground at the end of the day and for 5 minutes before the bell goes in the morning should you need to talk to them. The teachers will also be sending out their own class letters, with further information.

I would like to encourage you to first talk to your child's teacher should you have any concerns. I am also available in the playground at the start and end of each day. If the issue relates to another child, please do talk to the class teacher or a member of the Senior Leadership team and not the child themselves as this can often worsen a situation.

## Attendance

Attendance is a regular feature in our newsletters because it is so important. The Government sets a target of 96% attendance for every school. However, although we have been close, we have not been able to reach that target **yet!** Our first school rule is that *we come to school to learn*. Please do support your child in their learning and support the school in achieving that 96% target, by ensuring that your child is in school and on time. Whilst illness cannot be avoided, holidays in term time can. Please do make a note of the holiday dates below and avoid booking holidays or doctors/dentist appointments during school time.
