It was lovely last week to see so many classes out enjoying the sunshine!

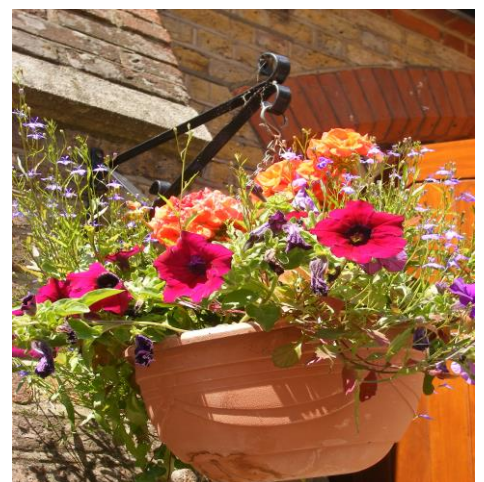
