## Job Description

**Job Title: Music Teacher 0.2**

### Job Purpose:

As directed by the Headteacher & the SLT, The Music Teacher will:

- Teach a class of pupils, and ensure that planning, preparation, recording, assessment and reporting meet their varying learning and social needs and meet school criteria policy.
- Maintain the positive ethos and core values of the school, both inside and outside the classroom and adhering to established ground rules of professional conduct
- Contribute to constructive team-building amongst teaching and non-teaching staff, parents and governors.
- Ensure that the current national conditions of employment for school teachers are met

### Main Responsibilities

- a) To foster a joy and enthusiasm for music-making throughout the school
  - b) To teach singing and general musicianship to every pupil 4-11 years
  - c) To ensure that national curriculum music objectives are met in all key stages
  - d) Liaise with colleagues to integrate music planning and schemes of work into their termly topics
  - e) To plan and co-ordinate the programme of musical events
  - f) To lead instrumental ensembles and choirs
  - g) To co-ordinate musical support for Mass, nativities, Prize day, special events and plays
  - h) To co-ordinate and manage the school music budget
  - i) To oversee the school's stock of instruments, arranging repairs where necessary, purchasing new instruments as appropriate
  - j) To encourage students, with the help of peripatetic staff, to learn instruments
  - k) To support colleagues in their endeavours to teach music with their classes
- Carry out any reasonable request of the Headteacher, or Assistant Head in the Headteachers absence
